Grounds Use Policy

The Perry Public Library is committed to providing recreational and educational resources to the Perry school district. To this end the grounds of the library are open 24 hours for use of library patrons for library operations, this includes returning library materials through the book drop, or using the library's WiFi network on personal devices.

For other uses of library grounds, permission must be given by either the library director or the library board of trustees. This includes, but is not limited to the following:

- Holding events or gatherings (this includes fundraisers or informational programs)
- Making changes to the grounds (this includes putting up signs or flags, removing/planting trees or flowers, or painting)

Library premises may not be used for soliciting, laundering, personal hygiene activities, or sexual activity of any kind. Facilities and grounds may not be used in a manner that substantially disrupts events or the lawful use by other persons; substantially interferes with the free flow of vehicle or pedestrian traffic; results in injury or creates the threat of injury to persons; involves commission of a crime or illegal behavior; damages or defaces property or creates the threat of damage to property; or results in significant littering, pollution or other nuisance. Any visitors to the library grounds are expected to follow local, state and federal laws. In the case of a visitor frequently violating laws or library policy they may be barred from visiting the library and grounds.
