Facilities

On 4/19, the new doors were installed, thanks to the donation from Mr. Warren Heilbronner. This is also part of the Library Construction Aid grant we are waiting to hear more about hopefully later this year from DASNY (Dormitory Authority of the State of New York). OWWL Library System notified us at the end of last month that they increased our funding recommendation to \$32,418. I had submitted updated quotes from the door company & one of the alarm companies as requested by DLD (Department of Library Development) as the price of construction has been everincreasing.

On 4/20, we also got our A/C serviced (normal maintenance).

We did discover that the switch that controls the exterior mechanism is faulty. Alliance is preparing a quote to replace that switch.

Miscellaneous:

We received notice that we were approved for the Causewave Grant. They are requesting we contribute \$850.

I was contacted by Arts For Learning (formerly Young Audiences of WNY. I provided a letter of support for their grant application to the Wyoming Foundation. If funded, the grant will provide programming through Arts For Learning to take place at our library.
