Toilets-Men's room shut off valve replaced due to noted corrosion similar to previously failed women's toilet. Then we noticed water around the base of the toilet and the tank was leaking so that was replaced. Downstairs bathroom had a faulty flapper, was replaced and has so far been working well.

NYS approved the amendment to the 2022 Construction Aid project to add security cameras and I also received written confirmation that there is a warranty on the cameras so we proceeded with Bear Communications. They started installation on June 24<sup>th</sup> and have been working around the weather. So far, we have 7 out of 12 cameras installed and they will be back this week to finish installation, provided the weather cooperates.

We were also able to get the parking lot sealed over the weekend of June 28<sup>th</sup>.
